James Gallagher (1920-2002) was a Baltimore native who worked in a securities firm and was an avid photographer. Jacques Kelley is a columnist for <u>The</u> <u>Baltimore Sun</u>, and states: "Each of Jim's photographs tells a story and conveys mood, spirit, atmosphere, and character. You don't have to be a rail buff to appreciate them."

2. The President Travels By Train, by Bob Withers. 1996, TLC Publishing Co.

John Quincy Adams was the first chief executive to record a train ride, and virtually every candidate since has made a "Whistle Stop tour" part of their campaign, at least up to George Bush at the time of the book's writing.
